



### Winsemius Awards Q&A

#### Who is Dr. Albert Winsemius?

The late Dr. Albert Winsemius was a Dutch economist and long-time Chief Economic Advisor to the Singapore Government from 1961 to 1984. He worked closely with Singapore's first generation leaders including Mr Lee Kuan Yew, Dr Goh Keng Swee and Mr Hon Sui Sen. As architect of Singapore's economic policies in the early days, Albert Winsemius and late Mr Lee Kuan Yew developed close relations over the years. Their friendly relationship symbolises the very close ties and connections between Singapore and The Netherlands.

### What is the objective of the Winsemius Awards?

The Winsemius Awards aim to identify, celebrate and motivate companies who foster collaboration and are able to influence and guide their company and/or industry for the wider benefit of the Singaporean and Dutch interests. The Winsemius Awards celebrate the long-lasting bond and strong business ties between Singapore and the Netherlands by recognizing and celebrating innovative and impactful achievements of businesses across all sectors. The first Winsemius Awards Event in 2015 was initiated to celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Singapore.

Held annually since 2015 with a 2 year pause due to the pandemic, the Winsemius Awards return in 2022 with the same focus on **sustainability** as before and with the award categories flowing from ADB-DutchCham's mission. The Winsemius Awards represent the most prestigious form of recognition for Dutch or Singaporean companies in Singapore on Collaboration, Business achievement, Innovation, Social Responsibility and Sustainability. The Winsemius Awards showcases the achievements of organizations in Singapore with an interest in Dutch business.

## What are the 3 categories of the Winsemus Awards?

Winsemius Red Orange Award The Red Orange Award highlights the importance of the long standing and ongoing relationship between The Netherlands and Singapore. The Red Orange Award recognizes the importance of effective business relationships and collaborations within and across business disciplines to tackle challenging issues.

The Red Orange Award wants to celebrate business collaborations which highlight what is working and what is possible when diverse companies come together to achieve a shared goal. The Red Orange Award recognizes a companies' ability to create value by its collaboration for the benefit of both the Singaporean as well as the Dutch business community.

Winsemius Outstanding Business Achievement Award The Outstanding Business Achievement Award celebrates the success of an organization and honors its business performance, longevity, development of a new direction, business growth and/or any significant innovations with tangible results and benefiting Dutch Business in Singapore.



The Outstanding Business Achievement Award recognizes companies for outstanding, innovative products, services, projects and programmes demonstrating the organizations leadership and resilience in these unprecedented times. The Outstanding Business Achievement Award also recognizes a company for its ability to achieve outstanding business results by creating an innovative breakthrough or developing a disruptive business or building back better.

Winsemius Community Impact Award The Community Impact Award recognizes and honors companies' commitment to positively impacting any of the Singaporean communities with tangible results. The Community Impact Award should demonstrate the company's leadership and commitment in acting inclusive and creating a significant financial, social or environmental value for the benefit of a community. The Community Impact Award will honor those companies which made significant outreach efforts that serve to uplift the community, specifically by promoting strong ethical and social leadership and integrity.

# Who are the jury of the Winsemius Awards?

Per award a jury of 4 well-informed and skilled professionals with relevant backgrounds judges the applicants and nominees in an honest, unbiased and unprejudiced manner. Each jury consists of:

- 2 ADB-DutchCham (community) members
- 1 professional from the Embassy of the Netherlands
- 1 Singaporean professional
